<u>OBJECTIVE:</u> The Ozaukee County Bowling Hall of Fame is dedicated to recognizing those individual members who have distinguished themselves thru service and dedication or skill to the sport of American Tenpins over a period of years in the Greater Ozaukee Washington Bowling Community.

- 1. **Meritorious and Service Division:** To honor members who have been recognized for their outstanding service to bowling, and whose long-standing hard work has contributed and dedicated themselves to the progress, welfare, and repute of the Greater Ozaukee Washington Bowling Association (GROWBA) and its affiliated organizations, above and beyond the call of duty.
- 2. **Skilled Division:** To honor members who have excelled in bowling, and whose bowling feats, exceptional accomplishments and outstanding bowling achievements have brought back honor to themselves and to the Greater Ozaukee Washington Bowling Association (GROWBA).

HALL OF FAME ELIGIBILITY STANDARDS: To qualify for these awards, the following prerequisites have been established.

- 1. All candidates must have actively participated in sanctioned bowling for a period of **ten (10) years** or more.
- 2. Minimum eligible age, 40 years, day of nomination

To qualify for the **SKILLED DIVISION AWARD**, a candidate must have **three (3)** of the following qualifications:

- 1. Held an average stated below in 1a or 1b for more than a minimum of ten years.
 - a. Women: Average of 170 or more.
 - b. Men: Average of 200 or more.
- 2. Has been a County champion (Team, Single, Doubles, and/or All Events).
- 3. Has been a State Champion (Team, Single, Doubles, and/or All Events).
- 4. Has been a USBC Champion (Team, Single, Doubles, and/or All Events).
- 5. Superior League Accomplishments (Team, Single, Doubles, and/or All Events).
- 6. Exceptional Bowling Achievements (League, Tournament, etc.)
- 7. Special Awards (Team, Single, Doubles, and/or All Events).
- 8. Other Titles won (Team, Single, Doubles, and/or All Events).
- 9. Other (Explain).

To qualify for the **MERITORIOUS AND SERVICE AWARD**, the candidate must have at least **six (6)** of the following qualifications:

- 1. Served as an Officer or Director of the Association.
- 2. Served as a Chairman of a committee of the Association.
- 3. Served or worked on a committee of the Association.
- 4. Served or worked in some capacity in the County Tournament.
- 5. Served as a League Officer.
- 6. Served as a USBC State Officer or Director.
- 7. Served as a USBC State Delegate.
- 8. Projected some exceptional contribution to bowling and to the Association.

HALL OF FAME NOMINATIONS

The Hall of Fame Committee (HOFC) shall meet at least once annually to consider nominations for new members. To nominate a candidate, the following directives should be applied:

- 1. Candidate applications can be submitted in behalf of any Nominee duly qualified:
 - a. Any current member of the HoF, in good standing
 - b. Any current member of the GROWBA board of directors
 - c. Any member of the Greater Ozaukee Washington Bowling Association (GROWBA) with ten years of GROWBA experience
- 2. Candidates may be living or deceased
- 3. All applications must be submitted by March 1, current year
- 4. All applications must contain facts and figures vital and necessary for satisfactory investigation by the HoF Committee, and the said applicant or nominee, if living, be willing to appear before the Committee if so requested.
- 5. Applicants will be reviewed by the HoF Committee and checked for credentials. Final ballots shall be mailed to the membership (Current HoF members, HoF Committee and GROWBA Committee) and be returned to the HoF Committee immediately.
- 6. If necessary, the HoF Committee shall conduct a secondary internal ballot to break any tie votes.
