2026 Women's Championships Handicap Tournament - Rules

1. ELIGIBILITY

- a. Tournament is open to all female adult Greater Ozaukee Washington Bowling Association (GROWBA) active league members or GROWBA Hall-of-Fame members. Bowlers must be at least 18 years of age.
- b. Teams and doubles pairs may consist of a maximum of 1 USBC-certified bowler who is not a member of a GROWBA league. Non-members are required to pay the \$8 membership fee prior to participation, or \$23 if not already USBC-certified.
- c. Bowlers may bowl twice in the Team Event, but only once in the Minor Events. Only the first Team Event score counts for the purpose of All Events, and there must be at least two different bowlers on the team they bowl with the second time.
- d. Unless otherwise specified, all USBC rules will apply.

2. ENTERING AVERAGE

- a. Averages used in this event are to be reported as follows:
 - i. **COMPOSITE USBC Average** from the previous season. If no average last season, can go back up to 3 years, but must use the highest league average with 21 or more games. Visit bowl.com to find your composite average.
 - ii. If current league average with 21+ games is 15 pins or more higher than the entering average, use current average.
 - iii. If no average, bowler will compete with a 200 average.
- b. Bowlers are required to report any rerated or adjusted average from any other tournament.
- c. Failure to use the proper average or make a correction before the end of the first game of competition shall result in the disqualification of the bowler if the submitted average is lower than the actual average (Rule 319a-3).
- d. Rule 319d, reporting of prior winnings, is waived.

3. TOURNAMENT FORMAT

- a. Bowlers will bowl as follows:
 - i. Team Event - Bowl 3 games on the same pair of lanes
 - ii. Doubles & Singles (Minors) Event - Bowl 6 games on the same pair of lanes. The Doubles event is bowled first.
- b. Handicap will be 90% of the difference between the bowlers average and 200 (90% of 200)
- c. Maximum score with handicap for doubles event is 1800 and for singles it is 900.

4. ENTRY FEES

- a. All entries must be accompanied by the full entry fee to guarantee a spot in the tournament.
- b. Fees can be made by check or cash via US Mail or by hand. **NEW! Pay for your entry online!**
- c. \$25/event entry fee consists of \$12 for lineage and \$13 for that event's prize pool. All optional event fees go to their prize pools.
- d. \$1250 to be added to the total prize pool by GROWBA.

5. OTHER TOURNAMENT INFORMATION

- a. Maximum individual handicap game score may not exceed 300.
- b. Maximum individual handicap series score may not exceed 900.
- c. The GROWBA tournament director on site will rule on anything not covered here and their ruling will be final.
